Curriculum Information

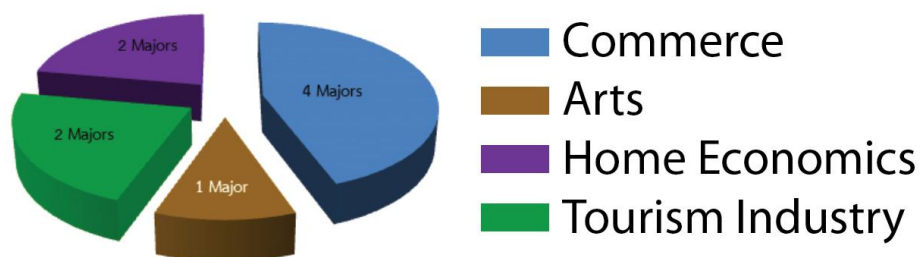

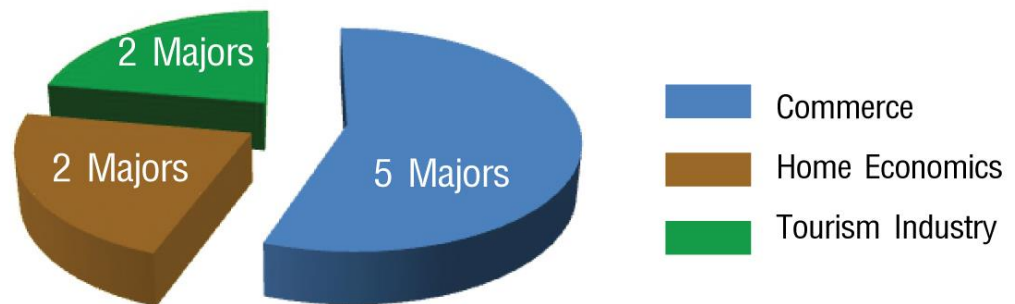
